



Raise funds for your non-profit organization with a Jackpot Bowling™ Fundraiser! Jackpot Bowling is a new, exciting, and engaging game that’s fun to watch, fun to play, it’s inexpensive, and you can raise funds in two ways.

<b>Ten Challenges</b>	
<b>1) Knock down at least 3 pins</b>	<b>6) Knock down at least 9 pins</b>
<b>2) Knock down at least 5 pins</b>	<b>7) Knock own 7 or 10 pin “only”</b>
<b>3) Knock down at least 7 pins</b>	<b>8) Knock down at least 9 pins</b>
<b>4) Knock down at least 6 pins</b>	<b>9) Leave a split*</b>
<b>5) Knock down “exactly” three pins</b>	<b>10) Strike</b>

**(( HOW TO PLAY - BOWLERS ))**

There are ten challenges. All bowlers attempt to win each challenge at the same time on individual lanes. If all bowlers do not complete a challenge, for example, no one rolls a strike, all bowlers continue to the next challenge. The top five compete for position. The bowler who survives with the most completed challenges wins a percentage of the jackpot. (60% for non-profit, 40% for the bowler). Tied scores compete in a sudden death roll-off.

# Jackpot Bowling Fundraiser™

## Two ways the game raises funds for your organization:

- 1) Bowlers pay a \$10 donation to play the game. The contestant with the most completed challenges wins 40% of the jackpot; the non-profit receives 60% (Minus expenses). Play multiple games during a four-hour period. Each game takes about 20 minutes. Bowlers can re-enter.
- 2) Prior to the game, spectators purchase tickets for a chance to win sponsor prizes when their contestant wins the game (Donations are \$2 for one ticket or three tickets for \$5).



The ticket or tickets are deposited into one or more containers numbered from one to five (1-5). Once the top five bowlers have been determined, each bowler is assigned a random number (1-5).



## Example:

If you purchased three tickets for \$5.00 and put one ticket in the #1, #3, and #5 container, your entry (One ticket) will advance to the random drawing for a chance to win a sponsor prize if Aaron, John, or Jack wins the game (The non-profit receives 80% or more of pick-a-player ticket donations).

All bowlers attempt to win each challenge at the same time on individual lanes. If all bowlers do not complete a challenge (Example: No one rolls a strike), all bowlers continue to the next challenge. The bowler who survives with the most challenges wins a percentage of the jackpot. Spectators make a donation by purchasing tickets for a chance to win a sponsor prize when their bowler wins the game.

Spectator donations are \$2 for one ticket and \$5 for three tickets. Bowlers donate \$10 to play one game. Each game takes about 20 minutes. Only amateur bowlers can compete for jackpots. You must be 18 or older to play. Sorry...No PBA past or present members.
